## Event Format & Rules

- 18 Hole, 4-Person **Scramble**: Each player tees off, the best positioned ball is selected and each player plays their next shot from within one club length (6 inches for putts) of that spot, no closer to the hole, keeping the ball in the same condition. Repeat this process until the ball is holed.
- **Gentlemen** play from the *White Tee Markers*, **Ladies** from the *Yellow Tee Markers*.
- Each Player's drive must be used at least **once** during round (track on scorecard).
- **Two-Putt Rule**: Once the team's ball comes to rest on the putting green, the team has one attempt to make the putt. If each player misses on their first attempt, move directly to the next tee box and record an **AUTOMATIC TWO-PUTT**.
- **Mulligans**: \$5 each, 3 for \$10, maximum of 6 per team.
- To celebrate one of Wes' two career holes-in-ones (one of which was on Hole 16 at Stone Creek) and to raise some additional money for the Wes Gavett Memorial Fund, we are having a special **Closest-to-the-Pin** (KP) contest on Hole 16. The cost to enter this contest is \$5 per player. The winner will get to keep half of the money raised by this contest (which could be as much as \$250) with the other half going to the Memorial Fund.

## Prizes

Prizes for **1st, 2nd and 3rd Place men's teams** and **1st Place mixed teams**.  
Tiebreaker starts with #1 handicap hole.

## Other Special Contests

- **Closest to Hole** on holes #6 and 14 (*all players*).
- **Longest Drive** on hole #18 (*Men*) and #8 (*Women*).  
*Mulligans cannot be used on contest holes.*

*Upon completion of play, please return your scorecard to the scoring table.  
Teams deemed not to be having fun by the rules committee will be assessed a two-stroke penalty.*
